


## Information for Course Instructors







Click on the Learners menu button on the left.




All students enrolled in the course are listed on this screen. You can see a high level view of each student's progress in the Progress pie chart for each student. You can also see the amount of time that the student has been using the course in the "Time" column, and the date that they last visited in the "Enrolled/Last visited" column.

To get a more detailed look at a student's progress, click on the three stacked dots under the "More" link, and from the pop-out menu, select "Completion".
